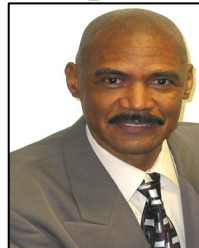
- Discuss the causes, effects, intervention strategies and treatment for abused and abusive men.
